9 INDUSTRY, INNOVATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE



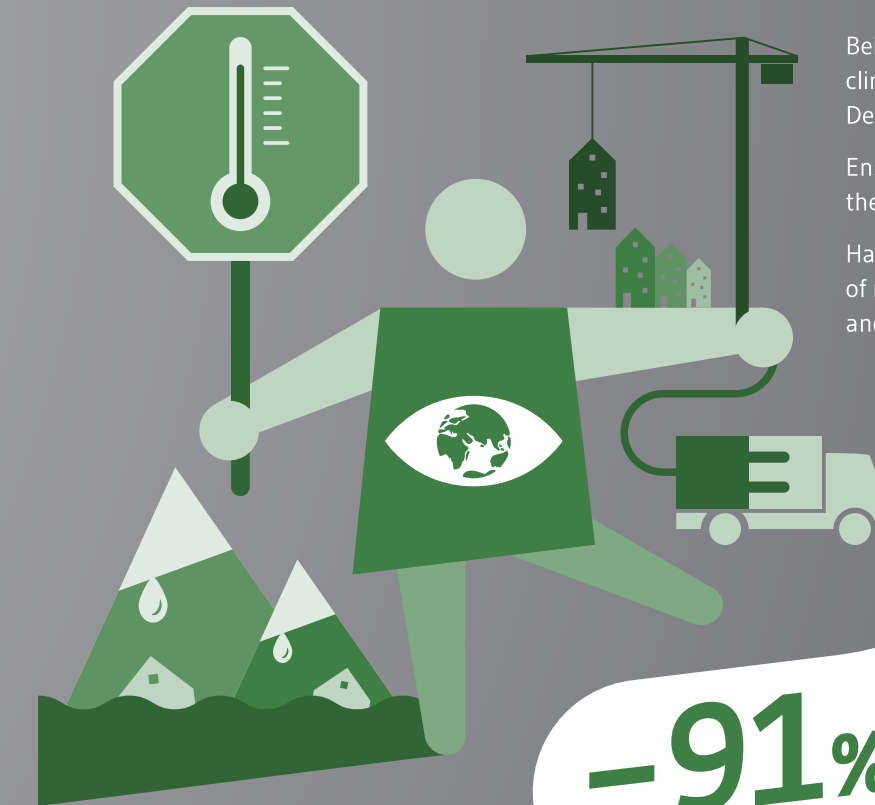
Supporting industry by setting up sustainable processes
